Unit Focus:

Students participate in a number of activities designed to help them deepen their understanding of people and events described in the Infancy narratives. Students appreciate Christmas as a special time when their families and parish communities thank God for the gift of Jesus.

Students are challenged to:

- Recognise the implications of Jesus' words and actions.
- Show reverence to and appreciation towards the Bible.

In Class:

Students explore the story of Jesus' birth in Bethlehem. They focus on the humility of the stable birth, to help them realise Jesus was born for all of mankind. In addition they may explore what they can do for others this Christmas and that this is the best gift we can give Jesus.
