Unit Focus:

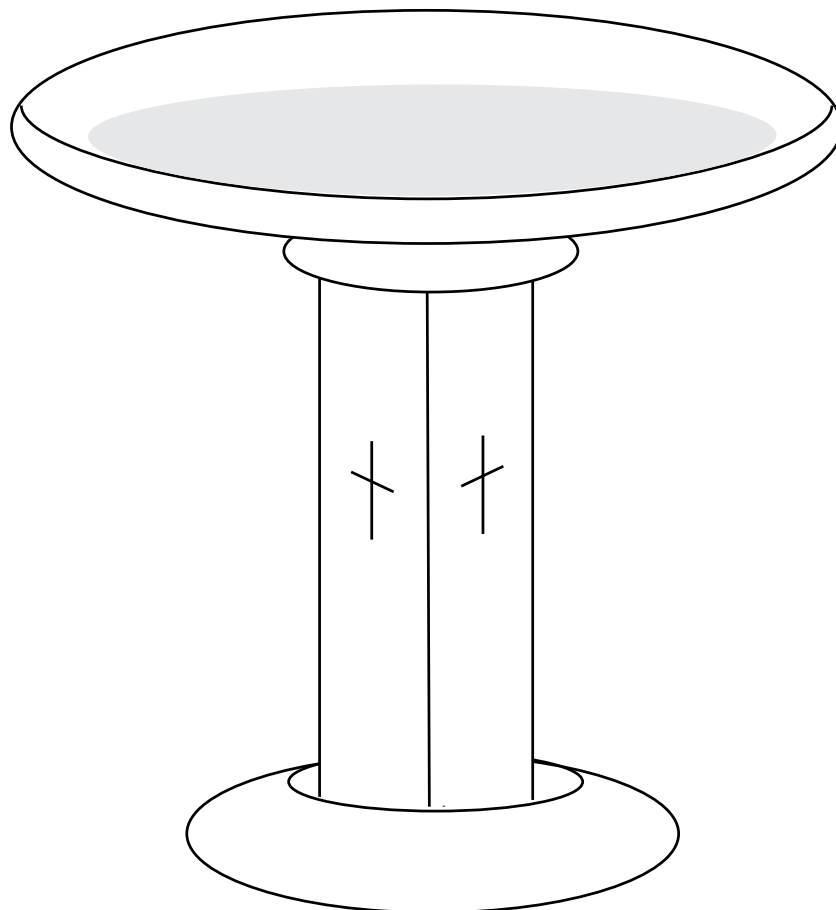
Students are introduced to the sacrament of Baptism as a celebration of their initiation into God's family, the Church. They learn Jesus was baptised with water and shows us how to live as children of God and study of the ritual actions and symbols used in their own Baptism.
