

What is the Season

Unit FOCUS: Students study the Gospel reading for the 4th Sunday of Lent: Jesus cures the man born blind from birth. They explore its themes of faith and spiritual discernment in relation to Baptism and the celebration of the Season of Lent.

Students are challenged to:

- Recognise Jesus in others and treat them accordingly.
- Participate in Liturgical Celebrations.
- Pray the Scriptures.

In class: Students have discussed the season of Lent and how people in their lives (family, friends, teachers) care for them. Students then link the concepts of 'talking to', 'playing with' and 'asking for help' to the concept of 'prayer' (communication) and that Lent is a special time of the Church's year for prayer.

Family supplement activity:

Students are introduced to their prayer journal and encouraged to write at least one intention that they will pray for and thank God for listening to their prayers during that week of Lent.
