

# Saying Sorry

*Unit Focus:* To support the Parish Sacramental Program for First Reconciliation. Students will explore the human experience of forgiving and being forgiven. They are introduced to the sacrament of Penance where we celebrate our reconciliation with God and one another. Students also explain how their choices affect their relationships with God and others and begin to develop an understanding of the experience of God's forgiveness in Reconciliation.

*Students are challenged to:*

- Respond as Christians to the presence of God in the world.
- Participate in the sacraments.

*In class:* Students have identified times when they have had a change of heart in their lives and reflected on the Parable of the Lost Son (Luke 15:11-24).
