

### 3.14.1 MOSES LEADS GOD'S PEOPLE

**Unit Focus:** Students study the Scriptural foundations of the Christian concept of servant leadership (witnessed in the actions of Moses and Jesus). As school leaders students are encouraged to apply these Christian ideals in their lives.

**Lesson Focus/Aim:** To introduce the students to servant leadership using the story of Moses' and his call to leadership.

**Students are challenged to:**

- Act responsibly in response to God's call.
- Relate messages from the Sacred Scripture to daily life.

**In class:** Students have explored the story of Moses and have discussed how Moses was a reluctant leader when he led God's people out of slavery.

**Family supplement activity:** Complete the Find-A-Word

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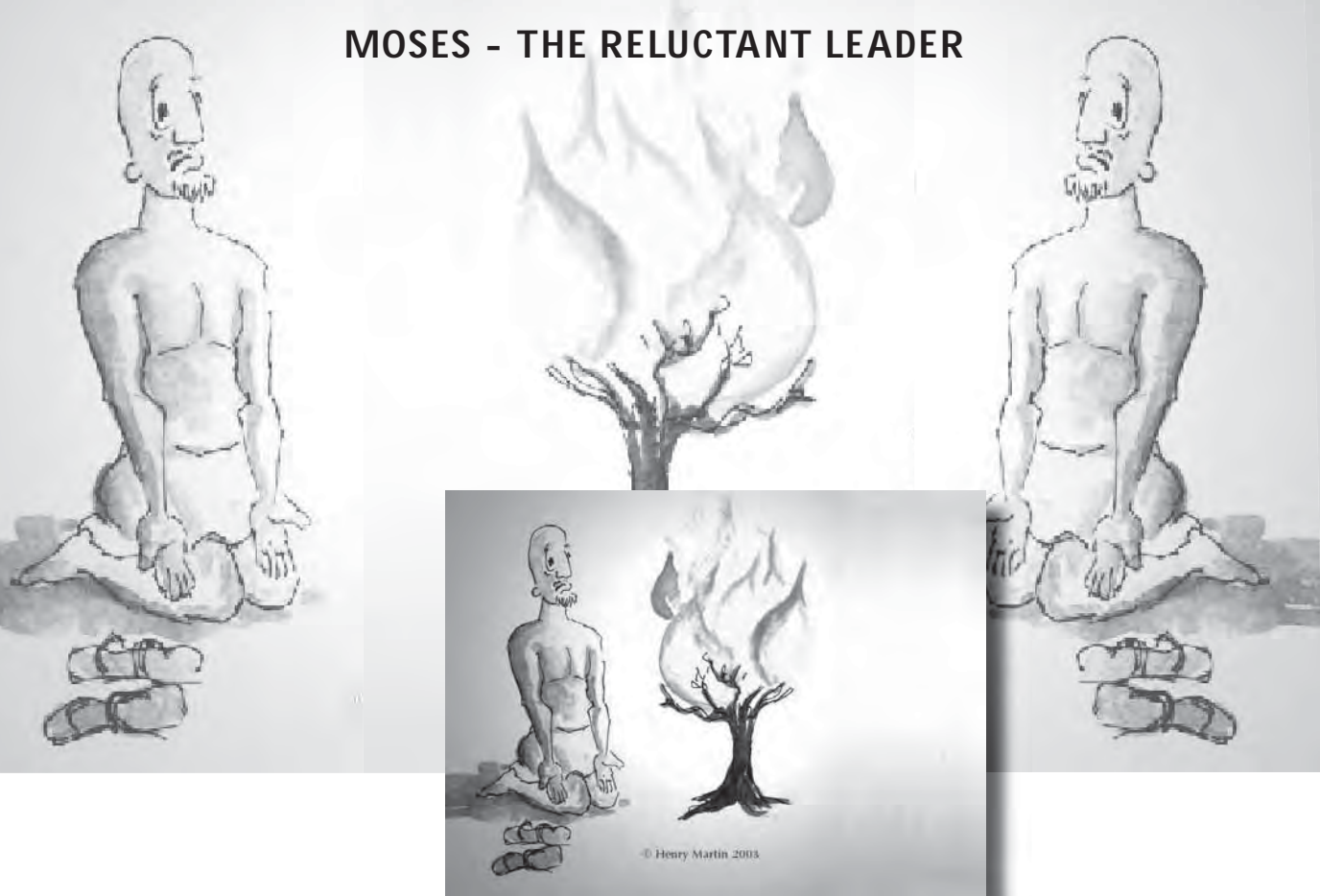
