NEXT SUNDAY 2ND FEBRUARY BE PREPARED!

and February is a special feast in our Christian year - that of Candlemas - the Presentation of the Lord. Coming 40 days after Christmas it remembers Mary and Joseph *presenting* Jesus in the Temple according to Jewish custom. There the prophet Simeon recognised and proclaimed him as 'a light for the nations'.

For that reason this has long been the day for the blessing of candles - next Sunday we invite you to bring your candle to be blessed that will be in the special place in your home as a focus for prayer. We will then invite you to place the candle on the altar where it will burn during the Eucharist, close to the sacramental presence of Jesus, the Light of the world, before taking it home at the end of Mass.

The blessing of candles takes place <u>at the very beginning of Mass</u> - even before the Entrance Hymn - so unfortunately if you're late you'll miss out. So please be ready with your candle for this beautiful and ancient feast in the life of the Church.

EXPLORING FUTURE DIRECTIONS FOR WOODS COTTAGE

As you know, in 1985, the parish established Woods Cottage as a residence for those with a mild intellectual difficulty and this wonderful service continues to this day. In 2015 we handed over the management of this service to CatholicCare Broken Bay while the parish committee continued to manage and maintain the building itself.

The Parish Management Committee now proposes that the house and the invested funds all be placed in the hands of CatholicCare to better provide for the continuation of this service in the years ahead. This proposal has the support of the outgoing Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Committee.

We now propose to have a Parish Meeting to consider this issue. This will take place following the 10:15am Mass on Sunday 16th February and we hope that you can be there to be part of this discernment.
