#### Update on "Equality" bill

The NSW Parliament has just voted to delay the "Equality" bill to October.

The encouraging news is that the Government have had every opportunity to push through this terrible legislation, but have not. It has now been delayed by over a year.

This is because of our hard work, telling your MPs to reject this bill. MPs across NSW have received thousands of emails. Amost every MP has had meetings with local faith leaders. A Parliamentary petition calling for the bill to be rejected has reached almost 12,000 signatures. Well done!

If you have already written to your MP, make sure you <u>sign</u> the petition.
