From Pope Francis on the Jubilee of the Year 2025:



- Pope Francis officially declared 2025 a Year of Jubilee with a papal bull, titled "**Spes Non Confudit**," meaning "Hope Does Not Disappoint." The Jubilee Year will begin with the opening of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve 2024. <u>Read</u> <u>the Pope's decree here.</u>
- The Bull is followed by a <u>Decree on the Granting of In-</u> <u>dulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025 called by</u> <u>His Holiness Pope Francis.</u>
- The Year of Jubilee follows the Year of Prayer in 2024, which was declared by the pope on Jan. 21. Since then, Pope Francis has urged the faithful to pray for peace, especially amidst the wars in Ukraine, Israel, and Palestine.
