

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) has released its Social Justice Statement for 2024-2025 titled <u>"Truth and Peace: A Gospel Word in a Violent</u> <u>World"</u>. This statement addresses the current global climate of violence and explores the pathways to peace through the teachings of the Gospel. It draws inspiration from Pope St. <u>John XXIII's encyclical Pacem in Terris and</u> <u>Pope Francis' Fratelli Tutti</u>¹.

The Statement will be officially launched on Tuesday 20 August. In the statement we learn that peace is possible if we put our trust in Christ who is the way, the truth and the life and the Prince of Peace. It is from him that we learn about the architecture of peace. From him, we learn a commitment to the culture of encounter, the value of dialogue at all levels and the importance of seeing everyone as our sister, our brother.
