Synod's second guiding document – what is it all about?

The Church is preparing for the second assembly of the Synod on Synodality in October and to help guide the discussion, as it did last year, the Holy See has produced a 50-page guiding document, called an **instrumentum laboris**. Australian Catholic Bishops Conference president Archbishop Timothy Costelloe said the fruits of the second meeting and the consensus that emerged would then be entrusted to Pope Francis.

“He will then, after his own prayerful discernment, offer guidance and direction for the universal Church as it enters the implementation phase of the synodal journey,” he said. The [new document](#) has a different structure to the last one.



What you need to know about the Synod on Synodality:

The Synod on Synodality, initiated by Pope Francis in October 2021, is a multiyear, worldwide undertaking during which Catholics were asked to submit feedback to their local dioceses on the question “What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our ‘journeying together?’”

The Catholic Church’s massive synodal process has already undergone diocesan, national, and continental stages. It will culminate in two global assemblies at the Vatican. The first happened in October 2023 and the second will take place Oct. 4–28 2024 to advise the pope on the topic “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission.”

What does synodality mean?

Synodality is “the action of the Spirit in the communion of the Body of Christ and in the missionary journey of the people of God.”
