

What you need to know about the Synod on Syn-

The Synod on Synodality, initiated by Pope Francis in October 2021, is a multiyear, worldwide undertaking during which Catholics were asked to submit feedback to their local dioceses on the question "What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our 'journeying togeth-

The Catholic Church's massive synodal process has already undergone diocesan, national, and continental stages. It will culminate in two global assemblies at the Vatican. The first happened in October 2023 and the second will take place Oct. 4–28 2024 to advise the pope on the topic "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission."

What does synodality mean?

Synodality is "the action of the Spirit in the communion of the Body of Christ and in the missionary journey of the people of God."
