## Synod in Rome Concludes with Spirit of Unity and Joy

The Synod in Rome has concluded successfully, marked by a profound spirit of joy and unity among the delegates. The gathering included 368 members, comprising 272 bishops and 96 non-bishops, who engaged in deep “spiritual conversations.”

Reflecting on the guidance of Pope Francis, writer Paul Elie shared, “We have been given a great gift of the Holy Spirit in Pope Francis...The Francis way of accompaniment is—you meet people where they are. You presume the good in them...You have a conversation. You open your mind and heart...trusting that something good will come of it.”

The Synod embodied this spirit of openness, as participants came together to discuss, listen, and grow in faith together.
