Envelopes are available near the exits of the church.

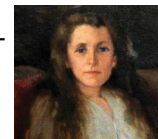

National Vocations Awareness Week 2024

On the 8th of August, we commemorate Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop, Australia's first canonised saint and cherished patron. Serra Club Broken Bay

The Serra "31" Club is a vocations program where daily prayer, monthly Mass, Adoration, and the Rosary are offered for an increase in all Church vocations those already serving the Church (priests, nuns, deacons, lay servers).

You can sign up to pray daily for vocations or pray daily and nominate a day each month (e.g. 7th) where you will attend an extra Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, or pray the Rosary, especially for vocations. If your commitment cannot be fulfilled on the day nominated, you may instead simply move it to another day.
