## Action required to halt the NSW "Equality" Bill

Alex Greenwich, the independent member for Sydney, has introduced a bill called the "Equality" bill. The bill has been before Parliament since mid-2023 and has been extended multiple times.

If it is passed, this bill will:

- slash religious protections for churches and schools,
- allow people to change their sex on their birth certificate at any time,
- allow children bypass their parents to get medical treatment and surgery,
- and legalise commercial surrogacy.

The Parliamentary Committee tasked with considering this bill have released their report, which found that **over 85% of people responding to their survey were opposed to the legislation**.

The Government needs to listen to its own survey and reject this bill.

**The most effective thing we can do is to contact our local MPs to keep reminding them how dangerous this legislation is. Christian organization "Freedom for Faith" has developed a resource to make it easy to find your MP and send them a personal message about your concerns. The resource includes a summary of the NSW "Equality" Bill, a guide to help you understand the proposed amendments, links to write, call or meet with your MP, and advice (with examples) on how to write these letters or emails. <https://contactyourmp.org.au/nsw-eq-write/>**
