I said to the man who stood at the gate of the year 'Give me a light that I may tread safely into the unknown.'


#### And he replied,

## What do the Readings say to us this Sunday, 1 January 2023, the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God?

#### First reading: Numbers 6:22-27

This Reading contains the beautiful blessing which has been prayed by Jewish elders for centuries. Joseph and Mary may will have prayed this blessing over Jesus.

#### Second reading : Galatians 4:4-7

This reading from St Paul reminds us that at the appointed time God sent his son, born of a woman. That woman of course is Mary, whose memory is honoured in the New Testament, and in the life and traditions of the Church. We have been given the spirit of sonship by Jesus, and it causes us to cry out ABBA Father.

#### Gospel: Luke 2:16-21

Shepherds, lowly and ordinary folk in the eyes of the world, come to greet the Christ child. Mary treasures all these extraordinary events into her heart and ponders them.

### A Reflection for the coming week:

"Hail, Holy Mother, who gave birth to the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, who rules heaven and earth forever."

Because she is the mother of Jesus, Mary is honoured as 'the mother of God'. As Vatican II puts it: "The Virgin Mary, who at the message of the angel received the Word of God in her heart and in her body and brought forth life to the world, is acknowledged and honoured as truly the mother of God and of the Redeemer" (Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, 53) [484-507, 966].

It is evident from St Luke's Gospel, that Mary was held in a place of honour from the time of the infant Christian community. Already she was revered as the Mother of the Lord, the one 'whom all generations will call Blessed'.

As early as 189AD St Irenaeus, and again in 217AD St Hippolytus, both call Mary Theotokos, "God bearer" or "Mother of God", and in 431AD the General Council of Ephesus taught that Mary is The Mother of God.

Mary, Mother of God, we love you and honour you.
