

Dear friends

With his own return to work this last week, Bishop Peter has insisted that I take some days 'away'! I am very grateful to him for his generosity. Subsequently, we will have a greatly reduced Mass Schedule this coming week, with Mass celebrated only on Wednesday at 9.15am and on Friday at 11.00am for the opening of the Prouille School year. On Monday, Tuesday and Thursday a Communion Service will be available in our church at 9.15am.

This weekend we have a very special event to celebrate: Norma Higgins has reached the great age of 90! We congratulate Norma and wish her the happiest of birthdays! May the birthday celebrations be a great blessing to Norma, to Athol her husband and all their family. Norma is certainly a blessing to us!

We also congratulate Ron and Joane Crowe on the occasion of their Golden Wedding Anniversary last Monday 29 January. We have had a number of couples in our parish family celebrate such a milestone together in recent weeks, and it is a great pleasure to extend our warmest wishes to Ron and Joane this week. We thank them for their witness of married love and pray the Lord's richest blessings upon them.

The celebration of Easter is a little earlier this year, on 1 April. This means, in turn, that the commencement of the Season of Lent is not very far away—in fact, Ash Wednesday is next week on 14 February. Next weekend we will make available to everyone a range of resources for this annual sense of spiritual renewal, and publish the various initiatives by which our own community will enter into Lent this year. This will include a special diocesan-wide initiative called "The Light is ON 2018." Every Catholic church in the Diocese will be open every Friday night during the season of Lent from 7pm -8pm for the opportunity of prayer. Next weekend you will see banners displayed in regard to this, as well as promotional literature that we hope might be distributed wide and far. Ordinarily, during Lent each year our own parish prays the Stations of the Cross during the Fridays of Lent, and we shall do so again this year. However, on the first Friday of Lent, Friday 16 February we will use the hour in the evening to join with the whole of the Church in Australia in a prayer of Lament for the sins of the Church in respect to the mattes that have been before the recent Royal Commission.

Also be sure to put in your diary a special event on Sunday 25 February when we will be joined by Professor Peter Bray, Vice Chancellor of the University of Bethlehem who will speak to us about the work of the Church there.




