This Sunday, 1st July is Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday

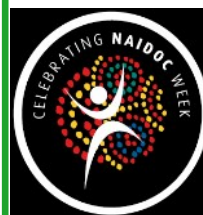

The clergy of the Parish of St Ives will most graciously support us during my absence. Fr Greg Chee, Parish Priest of St Ives, has been appointed Administrator of our Parish for the term of my absence, and Fr Sunny Peackal Abraham and Fr Johny Arattukulum will celebrate the sacramental and liturgical life of our community. Fr Sunny will serve us from 3-16 July, Fr Johny from 17 July - 29 August, and Fr Sunny again from 30 August to 10 September. The after hours parish phone number will be diverted to the priests concerned, in the event that there are any sick calls and pastoral emergencies.

Our wonderful Parish Secretary, Jackie Thornton, and our new Deacon Adrian Gomez will hold the ship steady throughout! The Parish Office will be the primary point of contact for any ordinary administrative matters of the community to ensure helpful coordination, and Jackie has been well briefed on the many practical elements that require attention in my absence. - ♦ The Sacrament of Anointing will not be celebrated again until my return.

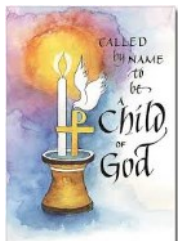

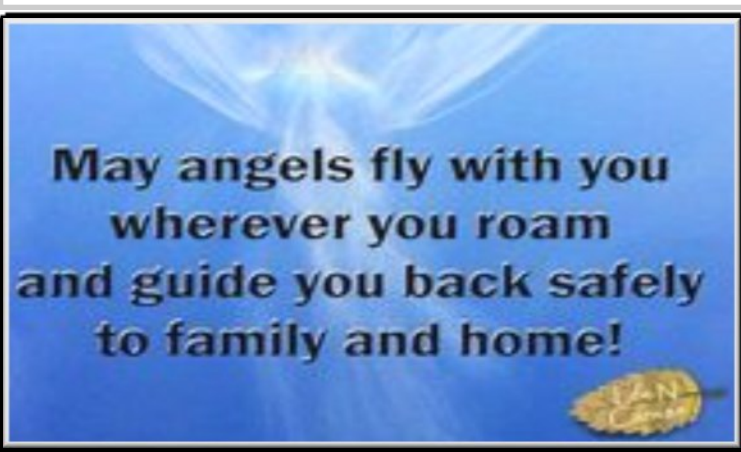
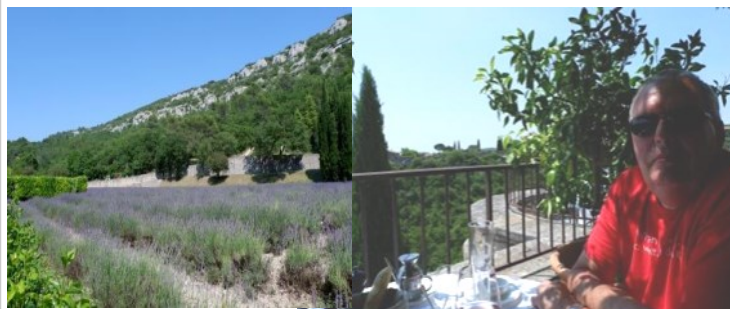

While we appreciate that many classes have their own get togethers throughout the year, this is a once in a lifetime event.

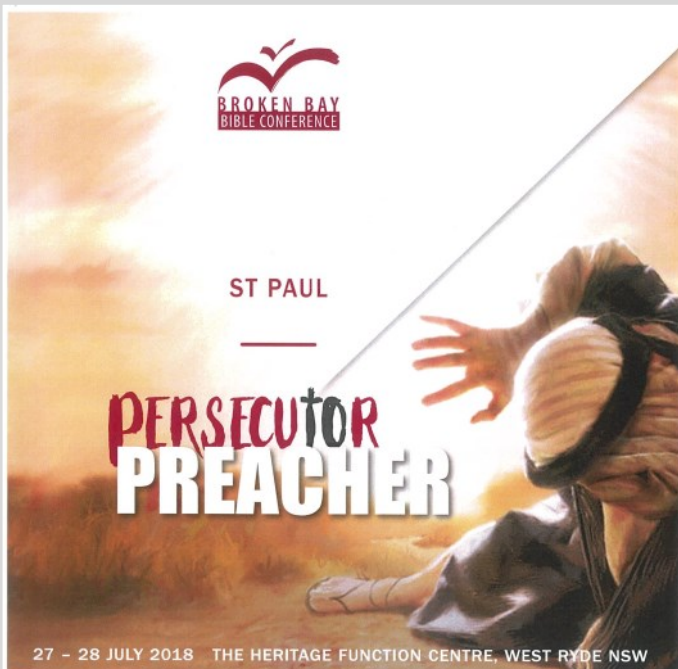
