From Fr David

Dear friends,

Once again our deepest gratitude to the Lattimer family for their generosity in the refurbishment of our Reconciliation Room in our church. The panels are now completely finished and I am confident that you will all agree that it has given a great lift to the interior of our church and will make the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation more inviting. The renovation also ensures that our Confessional is compliant with Safeguarding requirements. Through the generosity of the Raward family we will also now be able to attend to the interior of the rooms over the coming months. As I have shared it is our intention to transform the western room into a spiritual reading room, though that may take us a little longer to realise.

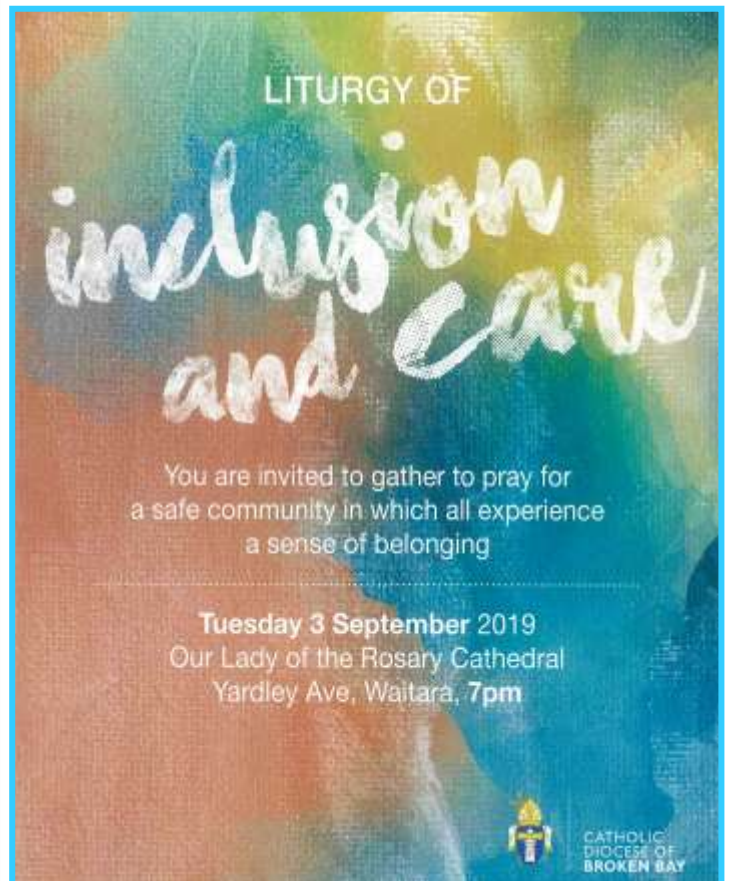
This coming week our Diocese begins its annual month-long mindfulness of the importance of Safeguarding in our communities. All of us have a responsibility to ensure that our communities are places of safety and care for all people, especially our young people. On Tuesday evening at 7pm our Diocese will gather at the Cathedral in Waitara to lament the ways in which we have not kept everyone safe in the past, and to commit to growing as a community of inclusion. This will be the fourth year we have done this, and all are very welcome to be present. Then, throughout the coming weeks of September we will introduce resources for our own parish to develop its responsibility for Safeguarding, too.

On Thursday evening, 5 September, from 6-8pm there is a special diocesan Safeguarding event on Cyber Safety. Taking place at the Caroline Chisholm Centre, Pennant Hills, it is being cosponsored by the Council of Catholic School Parents. The keynote speaker will be Kellie Britnell from Office of the eSafety Commissioner. It will take the form of a free MasterClass for parents and carers to assist them keeping children safe online.

Sacramental Snippets

'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me' (Luke 4:17-21)

The Gospels refer to the Holy Spirit assisting Jesus in fulfilling his mission. During this week our children have been learning about what happens in the Confirmation ceremony. They learn about the Bishop, what he says and does. They learn about what they will say and do during the celebration. They learn about the role of the sponsor. And they learn the symbols that are used in the celebration. The Light of Christ, the Word of God, the sealing with the Oil of Chrism and the sign of Peace. By the anointing in Confirmation, the one confirmed 'receives the seal of the Holy Spirit that marks our total belonging to Christ, our enrolment in his service forever, as well as the promise of divine protection.
