Dear friends,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of The Body and Blood of Jesus (Corpus Christi). The Mass, where the elements of bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of our Lord are the 'source and summit of our faith.' (Vat ii; Lumen Gentium). In celebrating this Feast it is a timely opportunity to pray for the young people from our parish community who will receive the Lord for the first time the following weekend at the 5.00 pm (Vigil) & 9.30am Masses.

During this week 12th- 16th June the Diocese of Broken Bay will be holding its Clergy Conference for 2023. 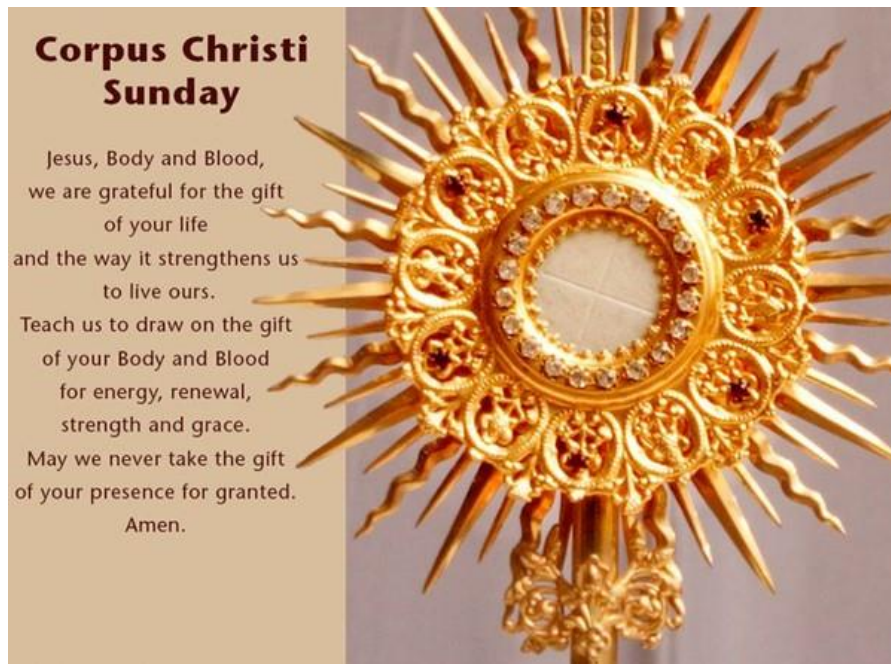


What do the Readings say to us this Sunday - The Most Holy BODY and BLOOD of CHRIST (Corpus Christi)
