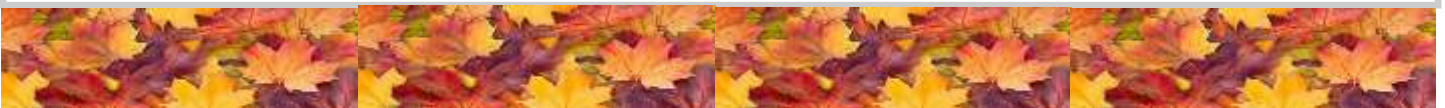

From Fr David

Dear friends,

With great sadness I share with you the death of Kathleen Busuttill, a faithful member of our parish family for many years. Cathy had been unwell for only a relatively short period with cancer of the throat and passed away peacefully at Ashleigh Lodge, Thornleigh on the morning of Friday 10 July. Cathy had been a teacher in our Catholic schools for a number of years, and I first met her when I was resident at St Gerard's Carlingford. She had been an active participant in our Table for 8 activity that we had going for some years in the past. Cathy is survived by her son and daughter, and two grandchildren and we extend to them our deepest sympathy at this time. We are very grateful to Fr Anselm for his pastoral care of Cathy and her family through this period. Our farewell of Cathy will take place at our church in a couple of weeks' time and we will provide the details closer to the time once they are confirmed. Eternal rest grant unto Cathy, O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon her.

The concerning situation in Victoria makes us realise how uncertain is our current situation at this stage in the pandemic. It is vitally important that we continue to act with care and with compliance with all that we are asked for everyone's protection. **Again, we stress that if you do not feel secure in a confined space such as the church—even with the safety precautions we have in place in accord with the NSW COVID19 Safety Plan for Places of Public Worship—now is not the time to be at Mass.** It is important that we make an informed decision about what is both best for ourselves and also for others. This extends, too, to the way that we receive Holy Communion. Bishop Anthony has not prevented people receiving Holy Communion on the tongue. And, therefore, people who wish to do so will not be prevented. However, it is important to think through the personal devotional practices we engage and whether they be in the best interests of others who may be concerned by their implications. Sometimes it is good that I evaluate a practice that may have great personal meaning for me, personally, but may be problematic for others especially during this period of great concern for public health. This is a personal decision that I have to weigh up in my heart.

A very special thank you to the very generous parishioners who have provided us with a brand new fridge in the Parish Sunroom! What a wonderful way to welcome people back to this great gathering space as events slowly begin to return to normality. Thank you dear friends for your marvellous care of us and for your very generous support.
