







Welcome Back!



How do we stay connected as a community during this time of severe restrictions in the pandemic?






We are introducing an initiative called Afternoon Tea for Twenty (20 being the maximum for outside gatherings).

From Fr David

Dear friends

Welcome back! It is good to be able to reopen our church once again and to welcome everyone.. It is has been quite disheartening to see such an empty church over these last two weeks. However, it has also been important that we keep the church closed, during the period NSW Health identifies as the term of possible incubation of the virus. Thankfully, there has been no community transmission from the church. And therefore we re-open with confidence, and also with a commitment to continuing our COVID Safety strategies.

As we come back together and as the days become warmer with Spring, we have proposed a new initiative called, "Afternoon Tea for Twenty." We can have up to 20 people gather in public during this time, and we thought a number of people might enjoy coming together in our parish gardens for a catch up with one another. This might be especially attractive to those who do not feel that being in the confined space of the church at Mass is safe for them currently. We will form whatever number of groups interest determines and start the gatherings in the coming weeks. It will be lovely to spend a little time with people in a way we haven't been able to earlier.

I am also working with CatholicCare BrokenBay to present a series on mental well-being for us during this time of restriction. The presentations will focus on how we can look after ourselves and each other during this time. We will make the series available through Zoom so that as many people who wish can participate. Stay tuned for details in the next few weeks.
















Celebrating Father's Day
