Please Join us for Mass

For our Sunday Masses we are limited to but 50 people, not including the priest and other ministers. To provide as many people as possible to attend weekly Sunday Mass we offer 6 Masses each weekend:

Saturday: 5.00pm and 6.30pm Sunday: 8.00am, 9.30am, 11.00am and 5.30pm

We will continue to make available Our Sunday Mass online. We invite you to register for one weekend Mass This will then be your allocated Mass each weekend for the time ahead.

Remember: In order to comply with the requirement of no more than 50 people at a religious gathering, we ask that only those who have first registered through the Parish Office attend a Sunday Mass. Please do not be unpleasant if you are unable to secure your first preference of time—we are endeavouring to accommodate everyone during these difficult times.

We are also obliged to record the names of those who attend each Mass so that we can assist in the Government's strategy of testing, tracing and isolating.

Mass will also be available Tuesday - Friday at 9.15am It is not necessary to register for these weekday Masses, but we will need you to sign in with your contact details. From Fr David

Spírít of St Lucy's

Dear friends,

This last week was scheduled as our annual Clergy Conference in the Diocese. With the lockdown and restrictions it was not possible us to gather at St Joseph's Conference Centre in Baulkham Hills as we ordinarily do. However, rather than not gather at all, it was decided to proceed with our meeting in a virtual way. So, on Tuesday night 72 of our clergy, on appointment and retired, came together with Bishop Anthony via Zoom. Following a presentation from him and some sharing from a range of Parish Priests about how their communities engaged the challenges of the pandemic, we prayed Evening Prayer together. We did something similar again on Thursday evening. On Wednesday and Thursday we met online in smaller groups for our annual Safeguarding Seminar and for a presentation from our Diocesan Financial Administrator, Ms Emma McDonald. The venture was highly successful and effective, and though the mode of meeting is not being considered as a substitute for face -to-face meetings in the future, it did demonstrate to us the online capacity also to bring us together. We think this will be of enormous assistance going forward.

We are now beginning to reflect on what we have learnt from the last several months. They came upon us so quickly, but as they say necessity is the mother of invention, and now we have new means for communication and connection. It is clear to me now that social media, for example, is now an essential component of ministry. Podcasting and YouTubing will always now be a part of homily preparation and delivery!

Little by little we will recommence our parish activities. It may be judicious for us to just see what outcomes of the recent public protests might manifest. These will be clear in the next week. On this basis, and with the lifting further of restrictions we will then bring back various parish activities. We are now in Week 7 of Term 2 of the school year. The commencement of Term 3 on Monday 20 July may be a good date for us to work towards to bringing a range of parish activities back to life, especially our Sacramental Preparation Programme which has been in suspension since mid-March.
