#### Aid to the Church in Need visiting speaker:

David Armstrong from the international Catholic organisation, Aid to the Church in Need, will speak briefly at the end of each Mass this weekend. ACN was founded in 1947 by Dutch priest Father Werenfried to alleviate the sufferings of the millions of displaced persons after World War II. Today ACN is the International Catholic Organization that focuses on the spiritual and pastoral support of persecuted Christians.

ACN supports about 5,000 projects each year where the Catholic community is unable to sustain itself. Since 2011 ACN has been a Pontifical Foundation. The charity has been operating in Australia for over 50 years. Some of its works include the formation of seminarians, existence help for religious, Mass offerings for poor priests, construction and reconstruction of churches and transport for pastoral care.

Dear friends,

It was a very restful and spiritually nourishing time, and also a lovely opportunity to be with a number of the other priests from our Diocese. A special thank you to all those who assisted here in our community whilst we were away, especially Frank Waldron for facilitating the Communion Service each day of last week. It was very much appreciated!

Sadly Ben Karpin and Lauren Kwon are leaving our community to relocate to Hong Kong. It was my joy to marry Ben and Lauren a couple of years ago, and to receive Ben into the Church. Ben leaves us this coming week and Lauren will follow in due time. We thank them for their contribution to our parish life over the last few years and we wish them every blessing in this new venture of their professional and married life.

Do avail of the resources at the entrance to the church on Safeguarding. Our Diocese sets aside each September to help us grow in our awareness of the importance of keeping our communities of faith safe and inclusive for everyone, but especially our young people and those who are vulnerable.

This weekend we are joined by David Armstrong from the Church in Need. This is an international organisation that assists the persecuted Church. As you might recall Caritas is the **Australian Church's crisis relief agency. It undertakes our annual Project Compassion Appeal** each Lent. Catholic Mission is the agency that assists the developing Church, especially local church communities in disadvantaged situations. The Church in Need presents almost as the third arm dedicated to helping Catholics and Christians, generally, being persecuted. David is here this weekend to share with us the work of Church in Need so that we might have a greater understanding of the extent of persecution that sadly occurs in our world today.

Be sure to get your tickets for the Sydney Male Choir that will perform in our church on the 29 September! This is the first of a whole series of concerts before the end of the year. Though entertaining they are also an expression of evangelisation as we reach out to those who normally would not come to a church.
