From Fr David

Dear friends,

As you read this, God-willing, I will have arrived in Rome to join the Bishops of Australia on their pilgrimage, Ad Limina Apostolorum-to the tomb of the Apostles Peter and Paul. From very ancient times, each bishop is obligated to make this pilgrimage every five or so years. The last time that the Bishops of Australia made the journey was in 2011. It is therefore for me a great privilege to be serving as Diocesan Administrator at the time the Australian Bishops are making the pilgrimage this time. The week long pilgrimage begins on Monday 24 June. However, I will join the Bishops the week prior on a retreat in the hills outside of Rome as we reflect together on the journey to the Plenary Council in 2020. Returning to Rome, we will celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St Peter, before meeting with the Holy Father, Pope Francis for 2 hours. All of us will meet also with the Congregation for Bishops, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, the Congregation for Clergy, and the Secretary of State. We have been invited to select a range of other Offices to meet. I have chosen the Council for the Interpretation of Legislative Texts, the Commission for the Protection of Minors, the Council for Inter-religious Dialogue, the Congregation for Religious, the Congregation for Education, the Congregation for Oriental Churches. Along with various receptions such as with the Australian Ambassador to the Vatican the week will be quite full! It ends with the Solemn Mass for the Feasts of Sts Peter and Paul during with Archbishop Comensoli will be granted the Pallium—a liturgical garment which indicates his position as a Metropolitan Archbishop. And then it will be up to northern Italy for me for a week visiting a good friend who is a missionary priest there and then some days in Paris before returning on the 15 July! Please do keep me in your prayer as I will you in mine.

A very special congratulations to Margie and Steve Knight on the birth of their first grandchild, Matilda—daughter of Alex! Of course, with Matilda's arrival Lillas Roche welcomes a further great-grandchild! Well done!

Sadly I will miss two great occasions whilst away. Allow me then to take the opportunity now to wish Lucian Wijetunga the happiest 80th birthday in the coming weeks—on 20 June! We thank the Lord for the great gift that he is to our community. And then on 27 June, Pat and Margaret Macmillan celebrate their 60th Wedding Anniversary! What a marvellous inspiration Pat and Margaret are. They have been so much at the centre of our community's life for so long. May the Lord bless them abundantly at this remarkable milestone!
