From Fr David

Dear friends,

On Thursday the 14 November Bishop Anthony formally appointed me as his Vicar General. This is a great honour for me, and I am grateful for the trust that our new Bishop has placed in me. I very much look forward to working with him for the benefit of our great Diocese. As Bishop Anthony continues to enter the life of the Diocese my work is much the same as it has been for some time. However, as the weeks go on, I will be able to be more present in our wonderful parish, and certainly I will be able to commence 2020 with a more balanced programme.

Recently, our Parish Pastoral Council enjoyed a very constructive discussion on Safeguarding. We engaged the question, "How do we make the awareness about our responsibility to keep our children safe come alive in our parish community?" The subsequent conversation was quite remarkable and helpful. In the coming weeks I will provide a report of the discussion in our parish bulletin. We also touched upon the question of how do we make our community inclusive of those with disability and some very good suggestions have been forthcoming in respect to this too. I will report on these in the forthcoming report

We also had a very helpful Parish Finance Committee last week, and were able to finalise our annual Parish Financial Report. I will now put the following touches onto this, and this will be available in the next couple of weeks, too. The meeting was the final one for Brian McGarry who has been a member for the past 7 years. Having now completed two terms Brian retires from the Committee. I wish to record my profound gratitude to Brian for his enormous contribution over so many years. His analysis, questions and encouragement have ensured that our financial situation is managed with the utmost accountability, responsibility and transparency. Our warmest thanks, Brian!

This weekend I am in Tasmania for the launch of a new publication of the letters of Fr John Wallis, a very significant pioneer priest who founded the Missionary Sisters of Service.

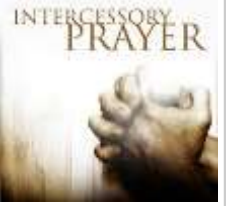

Bach offers Comfort & Joy at Holy Name Wahroonga.

The story of Christmas with its imagery of angels, shepherds, children, peace on earth and goodwill to mankind has inspired many a great composer throughout the centuries, however none more so than J.S Bach. This theme gave his genius free rein to compose music which continues to comfort, inspire and exult all who hear it.

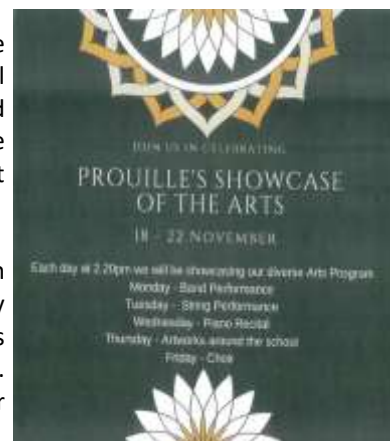
