Sacramental Snippets

Confirmation

Session 1: Remember Baptism

'Beloved, let us love another, because love is from God'

(1 John 4:7)

The Sacrament of Confirmation completes Baptism which marked the beginning of our Journey of Faith. So we start our preparation by remembering our Baptism story. This is a very special story as it reminds us that we are God's beloved son/daughter. How Baptism is the beginning of our life as a disciple of Jesus and the beginning of our life as a member of the Church. Confirmation challenges us to recall the meaning of our Baptism and to use this knowledge to form attitudes and values consistent with our growth as God's children.



Session 2: Called by Name

'Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you' (Jeremiah 1:5)

God loves me. I am unique and precious in the eyes of God. God calls me by name. At Confirmation I am again called by name. This time, I can answer in my own voice. When preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation the families listen to the stories of God's people in scripture who were called by name to do important work for God. The Holy Spirit, who came to us in Baptism, comes into our lives in a new way in Confirmation and strengthens us to participate in the work of Christ.
