Dear friends,

'A lecturer in a theological college informed his class that the subject of his next lecture would be the sin of deceit and that, by way of preparation, he wished them all to read the seventeenth chapter of Mark's gospel. When the time came he asked how many members of his class had complied with his instructions. Every one of them raised a hand. "Thank you," said the lecturer." "It is to people like you that today's lecture is especially addressed. There is no seventeenth chapter in Mark!"

What I find amusing about this humorous story is that we have all at one time or another been members of that class. Either we didn't do the required reading or, we tried to skim read the passage and hope that we wouldn't be asked to give an explanation of the passage in class.

Today, Pentecost Sunday, Jesus says that when the Spirit of Truth comes, the whole truth of God will be revealed to us. That Spirit, the Holy Spirit is with us today as we celebrate the first coming of His presence to the disciples of Jesus at Pentecost. But, even now we are being transformed and moved by the Spirit's presence, to seek to live and speak the truth from our hearts.

Let us pray for the Spirit's discernment to understand and have the courage to live by the truth.

What do the Readings say to us this Sunday - PENTECOST SUNDAY

First Reading: Gen 11:1-9: It was named Babel because there the Lord confused the language of the whole

world.

Second Reading: Rom 8:22-27: The Spirit himself pleads for us in a way that could never be put into words.

Alleluia, alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in

them the fire of your love. Alleluia!

Gospel: Jn 7:37-39: From his breast shall flow fountains of living waters.



At Pentecost, the Church is not formed by human will, but by the power of the Spirit of God. The disciples, gathered with Mary, are set on fire by the powerful love of the Holy Spirit.

The Church receives the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, right judgement, courage, knowledge, reverence, holy fear (awe) in God's presence. And, by God's grace, she reflects the fruits of the Holy Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control and chastity.

In the event of Pentecost, it is made clear that many languages and cultures make up the Church. St Luke (writer of Acts) clearly wants to convey a fundamental reality: that is, at the birth of the Church it is already "catholic," universal. She speaks all languages from the very beginning, because the Gospel which is entrusted to her is destined for all peoples, according to the will of the risen Christ.

Reflections for Pentecost, the Solemnity of the Holy Spirit


We are currently taking registrations for Parish children aged 5 years and over to join Fr Kelvin Lovegrove for a Program of Preparation for Baptism.
