Dear friends,

In the gospel of St. Luke this week (Lk 6:39-45) Jesus highlights how easily 'words' can not only hurt another person, or destroy their reputation, but words of slander and gossip, which are often untrue, can cause a person to take their own life. The internet and social media have their place in society as a means of communication, especially for those living some distance away. But it can be used for destructive purposes by those who want to expose gossip about another person which may be totally untrue. It would seem however that the loss of religious faith and the decline of a moral conscience, being able to judge between good and evil, has caused a serious decline in trust in our world.

Jesus says in the gospel: 'A good person draws from what is good from the store of goodness in their heart; a bad person draws from what is bad from the store of badness. For a person's words flow from what fills their heart.' (Lk 6:45). Rather than desiring the good of the other through our speech, today people's envy and jealousy become what motivates their hearts in bringing down the good of the other. Jesus reminds us that often what we most condemn in others comes from what we call 'projection,' where we ignore similar feelings in ourselves, but roundly condemn them in others.

This Wednesday begins the season of Lent where it is time to convert our hearts to the Lord, by putting aside all that divides and tears down our relationships with one another. St Paul says in his letter to the Corinthians: 'use only helpful words, the kind which build up what is needed.'

Let us place our trust in the words of Jesus who came to speak for the truth. In his response to Pilate in John's gospel Jesus says: 'all who are on the side of truth listen to his voice.' May we become the ones who truly listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd who leads us to speak words of love from our hearts.




The Sacrament of Reconciliation (First Confession) will be celebrated on Wednesday, 26th March.
