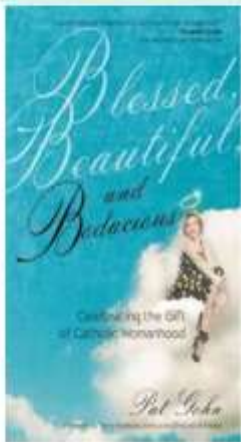


Journey Together Book Study
