# 23rd February -7th SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Dear friends,

As I indicated two weeks ago we are at present focusing on the Broken Bay Diocesan Program: 'First Fruits Offering.' I spoke about the program last week at all the Masses and about how parishioners might be in a position to either increase their weekly or fortnightly contribution, or for those who aren't part of the Planned Giving Program for the Parish of Holy Name, you may wish to become a contributor.



I mentioned last week that the First Collection is specifically for the support of the Clergy in the Diocese of Broken Bay. This collection pays for the clergy stipends and housekeeping needs. Fr. John and I thank you for your generosity to this collection.

But it is the Second Collection I want to focus on, as it pays for the running of the parish expenses. The Second Collection pays for such items as tree cutting & trimming, carpet, altar breads & wine, sacramental and catechist programs, water and electricity and so much more. Like your own household budget, the parish of Holy Name has to pay its bills and balance the budget.

However, important and necessary our maintenance needs are, we are about growing and nourishing the life of the people in our community. Hospitality and renewal are at the heart of parish life. This year of 2025 we have five people enquiring each week about the Catholic faith. Last year we had seven people enter the Catholic faith through the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) Program. Our outreach takes the form of morning teas, sausage sizzles, children's liturgy, celebrating anniversaries and birthdays, prayer and discussion groups and our prayerful liturgies and music. The St. Vincent De Paul help us to reach out to the poor and hungry. The parish community exists to follow Jesus and build His kingdom here on earth.

Everyone is invited to renew their Planned Giving Amount. The envelopes on the seats can be placed on either collection plate today. The envelopes can be sealed by tearing off the strip at the bottom which ensures confidentiality. All monies raised will go directly to the parish community.

I thank the Parish Finance Committee for their advice and support in preparing and revising the budget for the financial year.

Finally, on behalf of Fr. John and myself, we thank you for generosity and willingness to give to the parish in so many ways: by your presence, your ministries and self-giving which have enriched our community of Holy Name over many years and will provide for generations yet to come.







