First Reading: Ezek 37:12-14:

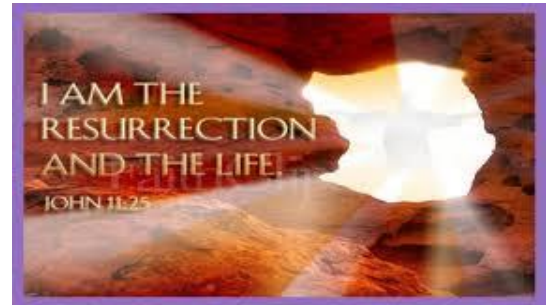
I shall put my spirit in you, and you will live.
