From Fr David

Dear friends,

This Tuesday 29 October our Parish Pastoral Council meeting will be given over to a conversation on Safeguarding: how we ensure that our parish can be as safe as possible for all, especially our children. We have thought to make this an 'open meeting' to which all are welcome to participate. Do come along and be part of the discussion about how we can strengthen our parish as a place of safety. Our meeting and discussion gets underway at 7.30pm in the Parish sunroom.

Preparations are finalising now for the Installation of our new Bishop, Anthony Randazzo. Do earmark the evening of Monday 4 November to be a part of this special and historic moment in the life of our local Church of Broken Bay. This is indeed a grand event and there is a great deal of work happening in the background to ensure the success of this evening. It will be wonderful that Archbishop Comensoli will rejoin us for the occasion. Everyone is welcome! The Solemn Mass is to take place in the Light of Christ Centre, beginning at 6.45pm. Be sure to come early to secure a seat!

The following day is our Parish Melbourne Cup Event!

October now draws to a close and on Friday we celebrate the 1 November, the Feast of All Saints. We will have the availability of Mass both at 9.15am and 7.00pm on that day. On Saturday, 2 November, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, Mass will be celebrated at 9.15am. As you know, November is a special month in which we remember all those who have died. We will celebrate Mass each Friday evening during November at 7pm.

Recently, the idea of a regular weekday evening Mass has been raised. This is not easy to resolve given that most weeknights have various commitments that make it difficulty to ensure the regularity of such a Mass. However, let us see how our November Friday evening Masses are attended as part of our discernment as to the wider pastoral need. Then, with my own reduced diocesan commitments, we can discern what may be possible in 2020.
