

Dear friends,

This week Fr Anselam has been with us for two years! Happy anniversary Fr Anselam! I cannot speak highly enough of the way Fr Anselam has exercised his ministry in our midst. He has done so with a remarkable quality of pastoral presence, kindness and generosity. For me, personally he has been an incredible support for there is no way in which I could exercise my role as Vicar General and remain in the Parish without the support Fr Anselam provides. We ask the Lord to bless Fr Anselam and to continue to strengthen him in his life with us. Fr Anselam will be on a week of annual leave this coming week and we thank Fr Joey for his assistance.

During last week, 64 of our children completed their preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation ahead of their reception of First Holy Communion through the weeks of Term 4. This has been delayed since March given the unusual circumstances of the pandemic. It was wonderful to see the children again, and our special thanks must go to all their parents and families who led them in their preparation at home, and to our Sacramental Coordinator, Sally Oong who has facilitated the program in such exceptional circumstances.
