28th July - 17th SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Dear friends,

During the next six weeks of the Church's year we divert from the gospel of Mark to the gospel of John. We will specifically turn to chapter six which speaks about Jesus himself as the Bread of Life. As the People of God, we are called upon to reflect and meditate on the Eucharist. The Second Vatican Council called the Eucharist: *'the source and summit of our lives.'*

With this text firmly in our minds we encounter Jesus feeding the five thousand who have followed him to this deserted place where they have nothing to eat. It is from the small quantity of five barley loaves (barley was the food of the poor) and two fish that Jesus multiplies the food that all may eat and their hunger be satisfied.

In our Eucharist, the Offertory procession symbolizes the bringing forward of these simple gifts of bread and wine from amongst the people to be given as the food consecrated for all who witness the miracle of the changing of this bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ.

While Jesus ascends the hillside (mountains and hillsides were the place where heaven and earth meet), Jesus blesses the food, and then has the apostles distribute the food. Likewise, the church becomes the meeting place between heaven and earth, and so we form the Body of Christ. Our Eucharistic ministers fulfill the work of the apostles by distributing the Eucharist to the assembly and those who are sick and hospitalized.

Let us today give thanks for this great gift which we receive, where Christ nourishes our deepest hungers for his love and forgiveness.

Eligibility: Candidates must be Baptised, aged 8 or older and be in at least **Year 3** at school. In our Diocese of Broken Bay, the Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated **before** Reconciliation and First Eucharist.

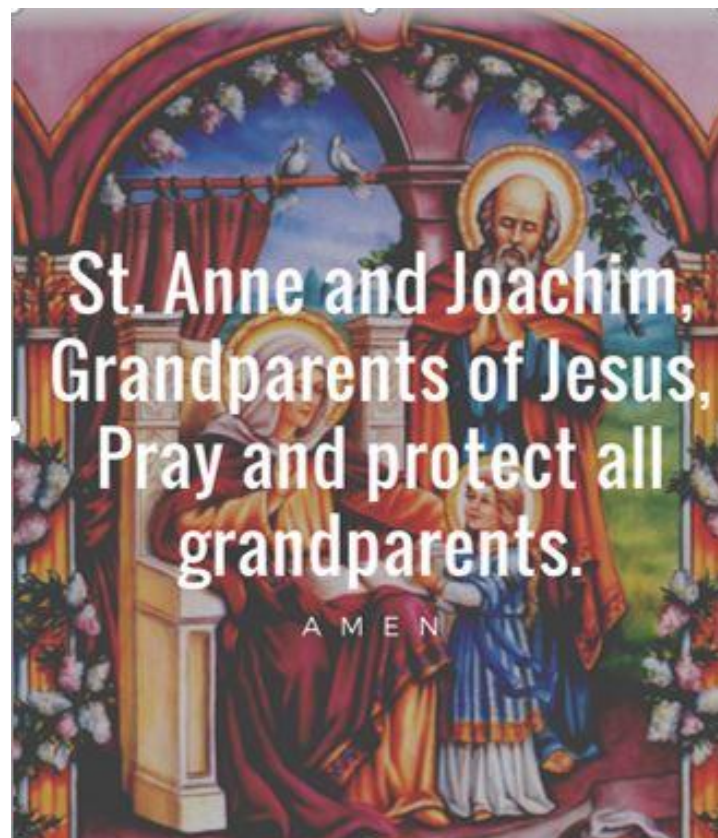


**CHILDREN'S LITURGY

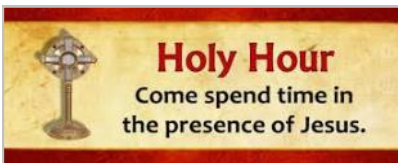
Senior Ladies Group First THURSDAY of the month at 2:00pm.

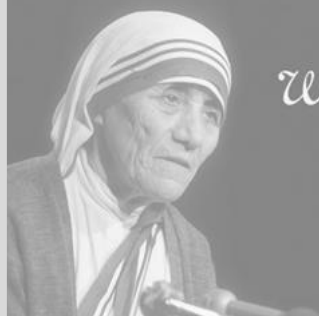
