### Mass is available Tuesday - Friday at 9.15am

It is not necessary to register for these weekday Masses, but we will need you to sign in with your contact details.

People may attend one or more of the weekday Masses.

Please note the church kitchenette needs to remain closed for the time being.

In the coming weeks, too, small groups in our parish will be able to meet again using our Parish Sunroom (limited to 11 persons). We are now hopeful that come August we might largely be back to normal.

# From Fr David

# Spírít of St Lucy's

#### Dear friends,

A number of our school children have now begun their holidays for the end of Term 2. This week, others will enjoy their final week of the term. Term 3 begins in the week of Monday 20 July. Our schools are hoping that their arrangements in Term 3 will largely be back to normal. And this being so, it will be time for us, too, in the parish to seek to bring back to life a number of pastoral programmes, particularly the Sacramental Preparation Programme. When we start Term 3 we will have designed the best way to do this. However, we are looking at 'combining' the preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist perhaps over a 4-5 week period and celebrating the Sacraments in the same week towards the end of the Term. In that way, our children who enrolled in the programme of preparation by the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2019 will complete their Christian Initiation by the end of this year. We are awaiting direction from Bishop Anthony in terms of when we will be able to accept a new cohort into a programme of preparation. However, most likely this will not be until 2021, given the continuing uncertainty of restrictions related to the pandemic. As soon as we have this information from him, we will share it.

As the current situation in Victoria demonstrates we must go forward tentatively and carefully. Let us all be sure to take responsibility not only for our own wellbeing, but for each others. Therefore, even though as from next weekend, the first in July, we will be able to gather in greater numbers (120 at each Mass), if you are unwell, or vulnerable because of health or age, or have a concern about the safety of a vulnerable loved one with whom you are in close contact, now is not the time to return to Mass—as much as we would love to have you with us! Be assured that we will continue to have our Sunday Mass available online. In this way we can remain connected in spirit and in prayer.



Do keep in mind the survey that we have available on our electronic mail out. The outcomes of this will be of great assistance to our Parish Pastoral and Missionary Council as we reflect together on the best way forward.
