Dear friends,

Like other painters of his time, the seventeenth century Flemish painter Rubens had a group of apprentices working with him. They watched closely and strove to imitate him. He would sometimes pause for a moment, gazing at the rather hesitant creation of one of his would-be artists. Then, seizing the brush from the hands of the pupil, he would add the finishing touches. It was those touches which brought the painting to life. Rubens interaction with his artist-disciples, is like the day of Pentecost, when Jesus' disciples who have been mentored by the Lord, now receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit, who now helps them to complete the painting.

Today as we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, often called the 'Birthday of the Church' because it was the first day of the birth of the Church. We, guided by the same Holy Spirit are called to go forth witnessing to the words of the responsorial psalm: 'Lord send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth.' Only with the love of the Holy Spirit in our hearts, can we go forth to complete the masterpiece of Jesus' making.


What do the Readings say to us this Sunday - PENTECOST SUNDAY
