#### Celebrating the 70th Anniversary of our Parish 1948-2018

This weekend we celebrate seventy years as a community of faith! We give God thanks for the countless people who have contributed to the building of our parish, spiritually and materially, over this wonderful history. As we look back with a heart of gratitude we look forward with a spirit of anticipation for the years ahead, praying that the Lord will grace us in new ways in the future.

# We celebrate our anniversary with the achievement of the erection of our Parish Bell Through the generosity of the Sullivan Family our Bell now takes its rightful place in the life of our Parish Community.

The St Martin de Porres Holy Name Parish Bell was forged in 1853 in Dublin and brought to Australia for the Sacred Heart Church, built in the 1890s in Darlinghurst where it was in use until the early 1950s. Mark Formby, the architect/draughtsman for Holy Name church was the one who chose the bell from Darlinghurst from the four or five in use there after the bell tower of Sacred Heart was assessed as unsound. In the early designs and models of the church, opened in 1954, there was provision for a bell tower on the eastern side of the nave. An arch built into the wall evidences this original intention. However, the tower was never built, and the bell

lay on the ground for many years, though it found a temporary home at St Leo's College for some years.

This year it is on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2018 at Bicentennial Park West Pymble and we have great program fined up. As in previous years we need help on the day for several different activities:

- Carols Choir. If you can hold a tune this is for you. All carols are in unison and you can have
  the music beforehand to look at. There will be three practices Sunday afternoon 18<sup>th</sup>
  November at 2:00pm at St Matthews West Pymble, Monday 26<sup>th</sup> November at 7:30pm at

- Volunteers to help pack our carols bags, which are key part of our fundraising activities; This

  volunteers should be from about 15 years and up. Volunteers over 18 years of age need to
  have a Working with children check.
- The most important activity which everyone can take part in is to pray for fine weather, safety for all concerned, that technology will behave, for the artists and choirs and most of all that the Christmas story will be told clearly and that Jesus name will be glorified.


