



A bout Pregnancy Help Sydney

Pregnancy Help Sydney is a 24/7 phone support line that is run completely by volunteers and has been in operation for 43 years!

It provides free support phone counselling for any one calling with any pregnancy related query or issue. It's a non-directed service in that we offer callers a safe and non-judgemental place to talk. We can't tell anyone what to do - in essence, our role is to listen with love and compassion. There are 30 volunteer counsellors located all across New South Wales.

I became involved 2 years ago when there was a call for volunteers in our Parish newsletter - and am now asking the Parish members for your help in 2 ways:

1. Become a volunteer support counsellor

PHS needs new volunteers to help keep the support line going. The training is free and is conducted via correspondence and over 11 weeks you will be provided with all the material you need to understand the basic counselling principles needed to answer calls. (It's is not time consuming and I found that it was very manageable even with a full-time job and family commitments).

There is also a weekend at Peter Canisius House in Gordon for 2 days of face to face training that will be held in June 2020. Following that you only join the line when you feel completely confident. There is also a very comprehensive resource folder that we use.

I can't tell you how rewarding this has been for me. From the skills I have learned to the incredible women I have met it is a truly rewarding experience and vitally important. My weekly commitment is 3 hours in my own home. Once a year there is also an annual conference here in Sydney for further training. All of these activities are funded by PHS itself.

2. Christmas Cherries - \$25/2kg

Each year, PHS runs a Christmas Cherry drive to fund the training programs and I will be bringing lots of lovely cherries straight from the farm in Young to Holy Name Church on 7 December.

I will be taking pre-paid orders after Masses this weekend/next weekend and via email at adweaver@bigpond.com Collection will be after Mass on Saturday (7/12) and Sunday morning (8/12). You can pick up your cherries when you drop your Vinnies hamper off!

This is a most inclusive celebration of the Eucharist, that is full of song, joy and student participation.






CANDELA STALL
