Dear friends

What a great joy was the School Musical, "To Find a Bunyip" at Prouille this week! The music, the singing, the lighting, the costumes were simply exceptional! Well done to all our children and the army of people who have made this year's musical simply one of the best! And a special congratulations to Mr Dominic Meagher, the creative genius behind it all! Now, we wish all our children and their families, and teachers, a great holiday at the end of Term 3.

This Monday I travel to Vietnam for several days. The purpose of my visit is to meet the families of two new students for the priesthood that are joining our Diocese from Xuan Loc, east of Saigon. On behalf of our Diocese I will thank the families for their generosity in sharing their sons with us. Vincent Huy and Thomas Tan will then return with me to Sydney on Thursday to begin their life here in Australia. Many of you will remember them for their time with us last year when they stayed in our parish for a period of discernment. They will stay with us for a few days before taking up residence at Good Shepherd Seminary, Homebush, and then return to us for the summer holidays in December. The arrival of Huy and Tan will bring the number of seminarians for our Diocese to a most remarkable number of 8. This is a source of great blessing and encouragement for us as local Church. Our prayers for vocations are certainly being heard!

This weekend, as Diocesan Administrator I am travelling to a number of our parishes: Lower North Shore, Epping-Carlingford and Woy Woy to admit to the Ministry of Lector, two of our seminarians, Martino Hoang and Hien Vu, and to the Ministry of Acolyte, another, Sam French. These are significant milestones on our candidates' journey to priesthood. Do keep all our seminarians very much in your prayer.

Fr Anselam takes his annual leave from this Thursday 4 October, returning on the 25 October. Though he has only just joined us, I have insisted that he not change his plans for leave which have been in place for many months. We wish him a restful and relaxing time over the next few weeks and look forward to having him back with us ahead of our great 70th Anniversary Celebration on Sunday 28 October. Whilst Fr Anselam is away I will seek to juggle both parish and diocese! Hopefully, we will be able to maintain our normal schedule as closely as possible over the next three weeks.

The Plenary Council 2020 is a gathering of Bishops and selected delegates in Australia to make decisions about the future direction of the Church.

Preparation for the Plenary Council 2020 begins with open 'Listening and Dialogue'.

We have been given an exciting opportunity to have our say by responding to the question "What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"

The Council acknowledges how important your voice, stories and experience of faith are in helping to shape the future direction of the Catholic Church.

What is special about this journey is that anyone in the community whether part of the Catholic faith or not, can respond.

In the Parish we are starting with evening meetings. We invite you to join us for an evening of engagement and rich dialogue. You do not have to attend all the evenings, come to one or two.
