## We invite you to register for one Sunday Mass

This will then be your allocated Mass each weekend for the time ahead.

Remember: In order to comply with the requirement of no more than 50 people at a religious gathering, we ask that only those who have first registered through the Parish Office attend a Sunday Mass.

We are also obliged to record the names of those who attend each Mass so that we can assist in the Government's strategy of testing, tracing and isolating.

It is not necessary to register for these weekday Masses, but we will need you to sign in with your contact details. People may attend one or more of the weekday Masses.

Dear friends.

numbers we will celebrate a memorial Mass for Peter at which we can all be present. We commend Peter to God, grateful for the wonderful gift of his presence in our parish family.




# Spirit of St Lucy's
