


The Parish Office will be closed on Monday, 5 October due to the Labour Day public holiday.

From Fr David

Dear friends,

Each year, a collection called "Peter's Pence" is taken up. It is normally conducted on the feast day of Sts Peter and Paul because it is the world-wide collection to assist the ministry of the Holy Father. It both provides for the needs of Vatican City but also enables the Pope to support various countries and churches in time of crisis and need.

This year, due to COVID-19, Pope Francis has asked the annual appeal take place on Through donations to Peter's Pence, all people can support the activities of the Holy See and its initiatives to express solidarity with those most in need, especially those severely impacted by COVID-19 at this time. With your support, the whole Church can continue – in the words of Pope Francis – "to walk to search for, visit, meet, listen to, share with and stop at those most in need". Last year Broken Bay parishes raised \$35,780.60, which was gratefully received by the Holy See.

Let us be thankful that the community transmission of the COVID virus in most parts of Australia has now dropped as significantly. We will continue to be vigilant and to maintain our COVID Safe practices but hopefully in the coming month or so we will also see a further easing of restrictions. On Friday the NSW Government published revised guidelines for churches that allow a small group of singers, five in number and socially distanced. They are small steps but at least they are taking us in the right direction. Let us continue to ensure the safety of each other as we come though this extraordinary period.

In the Diocese of Broken Bay, October 2020 will see a bounty of vocational activity as Bishop Anthony Randazzo marks a number of significant steps in the journey of several young men toward the priesthood. Three men will be ordained to the Order of Deacons during October.

In a year of many challenges Bishop Randazzo says it is a "sign of great encouragement to us and we thank God for the way in which the Spirit moves in our community bringing forth generous men to serve and lead our people."



Samuel, Aldrin and Roger

On Sunday 4 October at Solemn Vespers at the Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, Waitara, Bishop Anthony will receive the Profession of Faith, Oath of Fidelity and Personal Declarations of Freedom from three ordinands, Samuel French, Aldrin Valdehueza and Rogelio (Roger) Delmonte.

Samuel French, aged 26 said it is his hope "the sacramental grace of the diaconate may increase in me and my diocesan brothers what we have gained in formation, more closely conforming our hearts to the servant heart of Jesus in the service of God and His people."

On Wednesday 7 October at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, Waitara, Bishop Randazzo will ordain Roger Delmonte to the Order of Deacons. Bishop Randazzo will also ordain to the Order of Deacons Aldrin Valdehueza on Wednesday 14 October at Our Lady of Dolours Church, Chatswood, and Samuel French on Thursday 22 October at St Agatha's Church, Pennant Hills.

The last ordination to the Order of Deacons in the Diocese of Broken Bay was in 2017 and the last priestly ordination for the Diocese was in 2013.
