Dear friends,

In 2018-2020 the world experienced the effects of the COVID pandemic. It took a long time for us all to recover from that period in our lives. In some ways we haven't guite recovered fully from those years, especially in terms of church attendance. Given the slow recovery time from COVID and coupled with the World Economic crisis, perhaps now is the time when we can reassess our situation today in 2025 in a better light.

The Diocese of Broken Bay has done a lot of work since the pandemic in assessing the needs and progress of its 26 parishes since that time. To assist parishes in re-establishing both ministries and financial support, the Diocese is initiating a program for renewal toward our financial contributions called 'First Fruits Offering - Planned Giving Program.'

This initiative is not intended as a one-off campaign, but as a long-term effort to transform our financial giving. It is a time to focus and reflect upon the nature of our giving.





## North Shore Serra Club - Broken Bay


Serra is a worldwide lay organisation committed to vocations ministry and is affirmed

- To assist our members to recognise and respond in their own lives to God's call to holiness



The Sacrament of Reconciliation (First Confession) will be celebrated on Wednesday, 26th March.


