Dear friends,

This week we have St. Paul writing to the Corinthians (Cor 4:13-5:1) where he highlights for us how our faith transforms us even when our bodies may be suffering or ailing.

St. Paul says: 'that is why there is no weakening on our part, and instead though this outer person may be falling into decay, the inner person is renewed day by day...and so we have no eye for things that are visible, but only for things that are invisible.' The Spirit comes to us in our weakness to give us the renewed strength that we need.

When we are feeling out of sorts with coming of the cold weather, and are vulnerable to the flu or COVID we often experience the symptoms for longer than we expect. I remember once having an infection which was taking some time to heal, and a priest friend said to me: 'you will get through this.' They were the words I needed to hear. But more especially, I need to take heed of the words of St. Paul who in my struggle offers me the hope and promise that God is with me, and his presence is my greatest strength.

Please remember the young people from our parish community who are preparing to receive Jesus next weekend in the Holy Eucharist.

First Reading: Gen 3:9-15: I will make you enemies of each other: your offspring and her offspring.


Second Reading: 2 Cor 4:13—5:1: We believe, and therefore we speak. Alleluia, alleluia! The prince of this world will






Children's Liturgy is held during the 9:30am Sunday Mass (Term time only).

Days to Remember this Week

St Barnabas—Feast Day 11 June

Barnabas was an early Christian mentioned in the New Testament. According to Acts 4:36, his original name was Joseph 15:32). In many English translations of the Bible, Barnabas is called an apostle. In Acts 14:14 of these translations, he is listed ahead of Paul, "Barnabas and Paul," instead of "Paul and Barnabas;" both men being described as apostles.

He is one of the first prophets and teachers of the church. Luke speaks of him as a "good man" (11:24). He was born of Jewish parents of the tribe of Levi. His aunt was the mother of John, surnamed Mark (Colossians 4:10). He was a native of Cyprus, where he had a possession of land which he sold, and gave the proceeds to the church in Jerusalem.

In Acts 13:4-12 Saul, Barnabas & John (Mark), their helper went to Cyprus to proclaim the Word of God. "We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God" Acts 14:22b. Paul describes Barnabas as a hard worker 1 Corinthians 9:6





St Anthony of Padua (1195—1231) Feast Day 13 June

Anthony's birth and baptismal name was Fernando Martins. He was born in Portugal in 1195 to a wealthy family, yet he felt called to the priesthood and chose a life of poverty. At the age of fifteen he traveled to the capital of Portugal to study to become a priest. After his ordination, he lived at an abbey and was responsible for taking care of visiting guests. Once when some Franciscans were visiting, Fernando felt called to join their order. When he took the vows of this order, he changed his name to Anthony.

Anthony was not known for his preaching abilities and his superior told him, "Just say what the Holy Spirit wants you to." (In other words, don't prepare anything and God will give you the words to say.) His homily was so well received that he was from then on asked to preach to various groups. He became known as a great preacher as everyone could understand what he was trying to teach.

Books back in this time were rare and highly treasured. Anthony had a book that he often used for reference when teaching. One day it was stolen. Saint Anthony prayed that the thief would return it. His prayer was answered. The thief even eventually became a member of his religious order! (This is why Saint Anthony is often called upon by people who are searching for lost items.)
