From Fr David

Dear friends,

After 10 months of Listening and Dialogue and a period of analysis and prayerful discernment, the National Themes for Discernment for the Plenary Council 2020 are announced this weekend at Pentecost. The six National Themes for Discernment invite us to reflect, to pray and to consider how God is calling the People of God to be a Christ-centred Church in Australia that is Missionary and Evangelising; Inclusive, Participatory and Synodal; Prayerful and Eucharistic; Humble, Healing and Merciful; a Joyful, Hope-Filled and Servant Community; and Open to Conversion, Renewal and Reform. More information on each of the National Themes for Discernment will be made available in the coming weeks on the Plenary website. However, we have now reached an important milestone in the journey to the Plenary Council.

Our own parish community will have opportunity, too, to reflect on these themes in the time ahead. Our annual Mass attendance count this year demonstrated that we have an average of 629 people gathering with us each weekend. This number is the highest we have recorded. It is 'inflated' somewhat by the Saturday sacramental preparation we conduct during May—but then such is the case each year. This year's tally therefore indicates a sure stability in the life of our parish which is a wonderful sign of the Spirit's presence amongst us.

We extend our warmest congratulations to Sam Severino who turned 90 at the end of May. Ad multos annos, Sam! We also remember in a special way, Mario Severino, Sam and Betty's son who would have turned 60, this Sunday 9 June.

Sadly two wonderful families are departing our community to depart for the UK: The Kind Family and the Nash Families. At the end of the school term they are returning to the UK to be be closer to family having been a part of the Prouille community and our own parish family for some years. We are going to miss them! However, we wish them God speed on their journey and for the new chapter of their family life that is opening for them. Thank you for all that you have brought to our community in your time with us!
