Dear fellow parishioners,

As the animators for the Plenary Council, we would like to invite you to participate in the listening and dialogue session this **Wednesday the 17th of October at 7pm in the Church**. Our role is to guide you through the process so that every voice in our community is heard. This session is one of two that will be held in the parish between now and Ash Wednesday 2019 when this first stage of the Plenary Council process concludes.

The Plenary Council in 2020 is about the future of the Church. To prepare, we all are invited to reflect on the question: "What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"

Everyone is invited to speak freely and honestly, sharing from your heart. Pope Francis speaks of our Church being a synodal Church – a listening Church – and in this process of Listening and Dialogue, we are called to listen to one another, and in doing this try to listen to God. For it is in encountering one another that we encounter Jesus.

Some of you have expressed concern that this process will not enable your voice to be heard or that you are just one person whose opinion is not going to have an impact. If that is you I would like to say please come along, we need your voice now more than ever! This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for us as community to let the leaders of our

Church know what God is asking of us here in Australia. Our submissions to the council will not be as effective if there are voices in our community that are not present.

together.



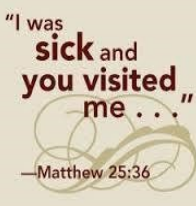
Prayer for HSC Students
