The infant Church in Australia had a
special reason for turning to Mary. In
those early and mostly
priestless days, it was
largely the Rosary that kept
the faith alive. Catholic

to Mary, and was the first
nation to choose her, under



the title of Help of Christians, as principal
Patroness.
