These are a few facts about homelessness and affordable housing. The Central Coast is experiencing a crisis of homelessness.

Who are the homeless? Look around and note. Three generatons of families sharing a dwelling, youth living together in groups of 6 or 8 on Newstart, children sleeping in cars with their parents, women staying in violent relationships because there is nowhere affordable to take the children, older women who are sick or whose husbands are in homes.
