Do you recognise your family or friends in this group?

Pensioners unable to find affordable rent, adult children living at home because of high rent, youth sleeping with friends and relatives due to high rent, families sleeping in cars, men & women staying in violent relationships with nowhere affordable to go.

All of these people are a hairs breath away from rough sleeping. Tense because people are outbidding each other for limited rentals. Rough sleepers are 7% only of the homeless. They need immediate help but the other hidden homeless need immediate help or they will be on the street also.

The Solution: *substantial growth of 4 profit Social Housing* implemented by the local council and the State Government.

We can make a difference for our children and grandchildren. **Watch this space.**
