





CONFIRMATION 2025

The Sacrament of Confirmation is offered to baptised children in Year 3 and older. Confirmation is usually the next Sacrament after Baptism, and before Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

STEP 1: ENROLMENT

Enrolments will be accepted through the Parish Office from Monday 24th to Friday 28th during office hours (9am - 5pm) and after Mass on Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th March.

Please bring your completed enrolment form (available from the parish website), and a copy of your child's Baptism certificate (if not Baptised at Terrigal), plus \$25.00 to cover the cost of the activity book, certificate etc.

Enrolment must be completed before the Input Evening

STEP 2: INPUT SESSION FOR PARENTS

This session will be held in the church at on **Wednesday 9th April at 7pm.** Please arrive at 6.45pm so we can distribute the resources. We aim to make this a relaxed, spiritual, informative evening. We will finish by 8pm.

It is essential that at least one parent comes to this session. If there is some serious reason you are unable to attend, please let Fr Vince or Janette know through the Parish Office.



STEP 3: PARENT & CHILD PREPARATION SUPPORT CLASS

This class will be held in the church on Saturday **3rd May at 3.30pm.** The class is be the main support for your child. One parent must attend with the child receiving the sacrament. Please bring your child's activity book with you. The class will also include a practice for the ceremony. We will finish in time for the parish Mass at 5.00pm.

The Presentation is explained on pages 34 and 61 of the activity book.


STEP 5: CONFIRMATION DAY 2025




RECONCILIATION AND COMMUNION 2025



First Reconciliation (Confession) is available for children who have been baptised and are in Year 4 and older.

First Holy Communion (or Eucharist) is available for children in Year 4 and older who have received Baptism, Confirmation and Reconciliation.



STEP 1: ENROLMENT FOR BOTH SACRAMENTS

Enrolments will also be accepted through the Parish Office from Monday 30th June to Friday 4th July during office hours (9am to 5pm) and after 5pm Mass on Saturday 5th and on Sunday 6th July after 7.30am or 9.30am Masses.

Please bring your completed enrolment form (available from the Parish website), and a copy of your child's baptism certificate (if not baptised at Terrigal), plus \$40.00 to cover the cost of the activity books, certificates etc.

It is essential that at least one parent comes to this session. If there is some serious reason you are unable to attend, please let Fr Vince or Janette know through the Parish Office.


STEP 3: PARENT & CHILD PREPARATION SUPPORT CLASS


STEP 4: PARISH PRESENTATIONS
