**The Sacrament of Penance**

Over the last few weeks I have explained that the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation or Confession) has four essential elements: confession of sins, act of contrition, penance, and prayer of absolution. And depending on whether these elements are celebrated individually or communally, we have three forms for celebrating the sacrament.



The first form is what we are familiar with, and the third form can only be used in the case of an emergency.

In the parish during Advent we will have the first form from 8.30 to 10am on Saturday mornings. A communal celebration of the first form will be celebrated in neighboring parishes and will be advertised in the bulletin. We will be celebrating the second form on Friday evenings (6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>) at 7pm.

The second form of the sacrament is a communal celebration: we will have a brief penitential liturgy involving a prayer, reading, examination of conscience and we will say the act of contrition together; then each person will come to the priest and say: "I am sorry for ..." and the priest will pray the prayer of absolution: "I absolve you from your sins ..."; then we will say our penance together. The priest will be standing near the sanctuary and penitents will line up to confess. Unless we have large numbers attending, there will only be one priest.

The individual confession and absolution in this second form is not a time for a long list of sins or for a discussion. If someone is seeking this they will be asked to wait till the end of the communal celebration when the priest will be available.

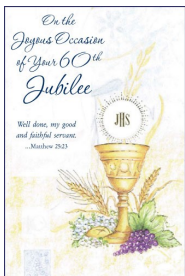

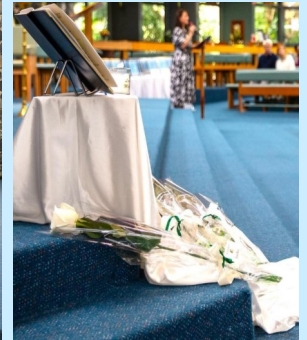

## Encyclical

'He loved us', Saint Paul says of Christ (cf. *Rom 8:37*), in order to make us realize that nothing can ever "separate us" from that love (*Rom 8:39*): Thus begins Pope Francis' fourth Encyclical, which takes its title from the opening words, **Dilexit nos**.

The Encyclical is dedicated to the human and divine love of the Heart of Jesus Christ: "His open heart has gone before us and waits for us, unconditionally, asking only to offer us His love and friendship," the Pope writes in the introductory paragraph.
